SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The ASML-sponsored student scholarship is available to students who are currently enrolled in a university science or engineering program, and will still be attending at the time of the conference, and who will be presenting a paper at the conference. To apply for the scholarship, eligible students must: 1) complete a regular short abstract paper submission on the conference web site, 2) complete this scholarship application form, 3) attach a one-page statement of research interests and experience, and 4) provide a brief recommendation letter from the student's faculty research advisor. This support letter must be on university letterhead and indicate the advisor's support for this application.

The scholarships are funded by ASML to defer the conference registration fee for selected students. These scholarships will be competitively awarded based upon the submitted short abstract, research statement, and faculty recommendation letter.

Award decisions will be conveyed along with notices of paper acceptance.

The completed scholarship application form is due on or before **January 31, 2020**, and should be e-mailed to ASPE at info@aspe.net. The faculty recommendation letter should be emailed directly from the research advisor to ASPE at info@aspe.net.
